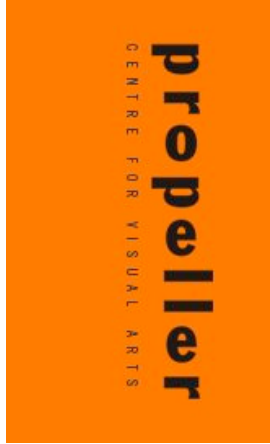

Submissions should include the following:

- **One image** only for of the work you wish to exhibit burned on a CD: 200dpi, maximum 1 MB and saved as a jpeg; if you send more than one image, only the first image will be considered. **Online e-mail submissions will not be accepted.**
- **Details about the work** including: Your Name, Title, Year, Medium, Size & Value as well as a brief written statement about the work (maximum 80 words) stating how it relates to the exhibition parameters. Please use a 10pt. Helvetica font and save as a Word file (.doc) on the same disk. Include a hard copy with your submission as well.

- **A Curriculum Vitae and contact information** which much include name, address, phone number, and e-mail; include as Word file (.doc) on CD as well as a hard copy on paper.
- **Non-refundable Entry Fee of \$45.20 (CDN or US)** cheque or money order made out to Propeller Centre for the Visual Arts.
- A self addressed, stamped envelope for the return of the materials. Entry materials without a SASE will not be returned.
